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The Americans with Disability Act requires educational resources be more accessible to anyone that might access College web sites and/or utilize applications provided by ChSCC. In 2015, Tennessee Board of Regents implemented TBR Accessibility Task Force and an initial assessment of accessibility initiatives was implemented.

The Technology Division is responsible for working with the ChSCC ADA compliance team to ensure ADA compliance is reviewed for new web site and/or application purchase/development, as feasible, IAW TBR and State guidelines.

“Accessible means that individuals with disabilities are able to independently acquire the same information, engage in the same interactions, and enjoy the same services within the same timeframe as individuals without disabilities, with substantially equivalent ease of use.”

All requests for Technology Division support for web development, software or application implementation should meet TBR ADA Accessibility Guidelines 2.0.

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Requests for Technology Division support for anything not meeting TBR ADA requirements must be approved by the ChSCC ADA Compliance Team, prior to purchase/implementation.

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Web Content Accessibility Guidelines 2.0 Level A and AA standard (WCAG 2.0 A & AA) for web-based technology will be used for all Web development provided by Technology Division.
